The Americans Against Gun Violence 2022 High School Essay Contest is now open to all U.S. high school students with \$15,000 in total awards.

To enter the contest, students must submit an original essay of 500 words or fewer describing their thoughts about the following statement by the late Supreme Court Chief Justice Warren Burger:

***“If I were writing the Bill of Rights now, there wouldn't be any such thing as the Second Amendment\*... This has been the subject of one of the greatest pieces of fraud - I repeat the word ‘fraud’ - on the American public by special interest groups that I have ever seen in my lifetime.”***
